Parent's Code of Conduct

It is imperative that parents conduct themselves in a proper manner at all times during the Season. Absolutely no swearing or harassment will be permitted. In the event that conduct is not acceptable, the Board of Directors may take disciplinary action that may include suspension of an offending parent's player from the program.

No coach or spectator shall at any time use signs, gestures, degrading personal comments, or any act, which will reflect unfavorably upon the TBTYLL, opposing coaches, players or spectators.

The MBYLL and TBTYLL require good sportsmanship and respect from all of its participants. The MBYLL and TBTYLL will aggressively enforce this policy.

Parents Pledge:

I have read and understand the *Parent's Code of Conduct*. Therefore, I will:

- ◆ Not force an unwilling child to participate in sports.
- ◆ Remember that children are involved in organized sports for their enjoyment, not mine.
- ◆ Teach my child that hard work and an honest effort is more important than a victory.
- ◆ Help my child work toward skill improvement and good sportsmanship in every game. My child will then be a winner, even in defeat.
- ◆ Not ridicule my child or others for making a mistake during a game.
- ◆ Set a good example. I understand that children learn best by good examples.
- ◆ Applaud good plays by members of our team and by members of the opposing team.
- ◆ Not publicly question a referee's or coach's judgment.
- ◆ Recognize the value and importance of volunteer coaches and officials and give them due respect. I know that without them, there would not be a TBTYLL or MBYLL.
- ◆ Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from youth sporting activities.
